BANK ONE NORTH AUSTIN (FORMERLY TEXAS AMERICAN BANK) AUSTIN, TX



GROSS BUILDING AREA

- 80,000 sf

GROSS PROJECT AREA

- 110,000 sf

HIGHLIGHTS

- New atrium connector that creates vertical transitions to the new tower addition.
- Existing building was refaced to achieve architectural design compatibility while retaining its original structural elements.
- New cantilevered entry canopies were used to create shading and massing.
- Tripartite organization of the exterior is executed through a series of setbacks and punched windows, coupled with dark to light shades of color that contrast with solar efficient green glass.
- The geometric square and triangle motif reoccurs throughout the building.

INTERIOR DESIGN • BANK ONE - NORTH AUSTIN • (FORMERLY TEXAS AMERICAN BANK) • The design of this project involved the addition of a 5 story bank/office building to the existing 2 story bank building on a 5.5 acre site along with a new motor bank facility. • The design unified the new tower and existing building into a harmonious architectural complex that avoided an “add-on” appearance. • This was achieved by tying the existing floor levels into a new atrium connector, creating vertical transitions to the tower addition.

- 148,400 sf

GROSS PROJECT AREA

- 148,400 sf

HIGHLIGHTS

- New 18,000 sf Training/Classroom/Lounge area within the overall 148,000 sf renovation.
- Vaulted ceilings with a spline of light defines circulation routes.
- Phased construction with no unplanned outages.
- Continuous 24/7 operation during all phases of construction.
- Coordination of audio/visual equipment and indirect lighting.
- New 225 KVA UPS System and 1200 KW Emergency Generator.
- Award of Merit - 2000 International Illumination Design Award - Illuminating Engineering Society of North America.
